In order to be eligible for the PAFR award, a government must also submit its comprehensive annual financial report (CAFR) to GFOA's Certificate of Achievement for Excellent in Financial Reporting Program and receive the CAFR award for the current fiscal year. Each eligible report is reviewed by judges who evaluate the report based on the following categories: reader appeal, understandability, distribution methods, creativity and other elements.
